

WOTC is a federal hiring incentive available to organizations that hire individuals from certain targeted groups that face significant barriers to employment, including veterans, individuals with disabilities, and long-term welfare recipients. Hiring these individuals can earn you tax credits ranging from \$2,400 to \$9,600 per qualified individual. We help you navigate the process by screening candidates for eligibility and filing the paperwork on qualified hires, saving you time and money.

JUSTICE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Be an operating & registered business

For profit

Demonstrated need for credit

Show ability to repay
